Tambour door Details

800,1000 and 1200mm widths, heights from 690 to 2220, available

800mm wide : single door

1000 and 1200mm : double door

30mm ribbed tambour laths, Anti-static material.

Moulded inset handle.

Carcass Construction

Fully welded carcass with flush fitting back panel.

Panels are blanked and formed using CNC controlled machinery to ensure consistent tolerance are maintained.

Panels are joined by Medium Frequency Resistance Welding in fully automated robotic weld cells.

Welded carcasses are hand finished prior to pre-treatment and coating using Epoxy Powder.

Tambour and Double Door units are fitted with full height internal steel panels, slotted at 25mm vertical intervals, to accept static and pull-out accessories.

Double doors sit flush with the front of the carcass when closed.

Top panel does not extend beyond sides allowing units to be installed in banks without gaps.

Drawers and Flippers

Drawers and Flippers are available in 800mm and 1000mm widths, Module heights of 300mm and 400mm

Drawers are suspended on full extension ballbearing slides, with pull back mechanism, to ensure drawers close correctly.

All drawer units are fitted with anti-tilt mechanisms on both sides of the drawer, for safety and security.

Locking Mechanism and key detail

Removable barrel lock with 2 split bow keys, which suite with all other products in the range 2000 differs.
